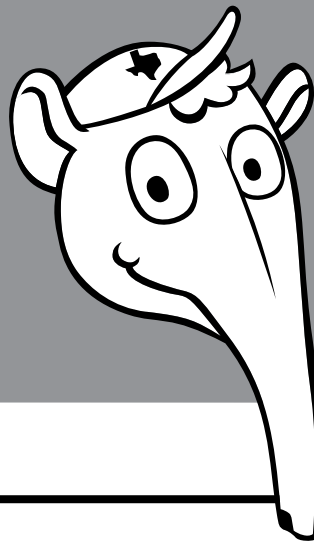


Fact or Fallacy
